- Since the requirement of the stipend is service to your community, how do you see yourself contributing to your community after you graduate?

Format:

- 1" margins
- 12 pt. font
- double-spaced
- typed
- free of grammatical, punctuation, and spelling errors

Personal essay is not to exceed 2 pages. Essays that do not meet the format requirements will not be considered. Essays must demonstrate organization in thought, reflection, and critical thinking. It must be communicated in a clear and organized manner.
